RULES AND ENTRY FORM

2025 Theme - Christmas Movie Magic

EVENT DESCRIPTION

The 2025 Gingerbread House Challenge will take place at the Village at Woods Edge Thursday, December 4 through Monday, December 15. Team up with your friends, family, or coworkers and display your holiday spirit and creativity by constructing a gingerbread house for a good cause. Entries will compete online and at a closing reception event to see which team will be crowned the Gingerbread Champion. Every \$1 donation from our community counts as one vote towards your team's entry!

ENTRIES AND EVALUATION

Theme and Design:

The 2025 theme for contest entries is "**Christmas Movie Magic.**" Entries are not limited to the structure of a traditional house and can be any creative scene or interpretation that includes elements of your chosen holiday movie. Competitors are welcomed and encouraged to uniquely design their entry for the competition as long as the entry is in keeping with the competition rules and procedures. Some examples include It's a Wonderful Life, Frosty the Snowman, Christmas Vacation, Elf, the Grinch that Stole Christmas, White Christmas, and the Polar Express.

Size Limits:

Entry must be placed on a base. Entries combined with the base must not be larger than 24 inches high, 24 inches wide, and 24 inches long. We suggest using ½" or ¾" plywood as a base for your entry for stability, but anything sturdy is accepted.

Use of pegs or risers on the bottom of the base is allowed for ease of transport but not required. If you wish to install "legs" on the underside of your base, they are considered part of the base and should not cause the entry's height to exceed 24 inches.

Materials:

All visible elements of your entry must be edible. Interior structures are allowed to be made of non-edible material (those inside the structures that cannot be seen). The main structure of your entry must be constructed from gingerbread, some of which should be exposed. Gingerbread may be homemade, or pre-made kits may be used.

Edible materials are not limited to gingerbread, candies and icings. Creativity in using other edible materials is encouraged - think pretzels, cereals, rice krispie treats - anything is possible! Handmade elements are encouraged. Note that refrigeration for entries will not be provided - all will be displayed publicly for 10 days.

Power sources will not be provided. If you choose to add lighted or powered elements, they should be battery powered. Non-edible materials such as paint, fabric, wrapping paper, foil, and ribbon are approved only to cover the base - not to exceed the length and/or width of the base. All structures must be free standing with ability to be viewed on all sides.

Entry Narrative:

Each team is required to submit a brief narrative with their entry. Share why your design is the best! How did you decide on your design? What does it say about your organization or team? Narratives will be included in social media posts and displayed with the houses that can be viewed by the public. Please keep your narrative to 200 words or less and email to director@franklinunitedway.org.

Community Choice Voting:

Each entry will be on display at the Village at Woods Edge to be viewed by the public from December 5-15. Displays will include the name of the team, the submitted narrative, and a link to vote online by making a donation. Each dollar donated counts as one vote. Donors will choose which Gingerbread House team entry to designate their vote for when donating online.

Online voting will open on Friday, December 5 and will end at midnight on Sunday, December 14. Links for voting will be posted on social media, with photos of each entry - teams are encouraged to share and ask for support for their entry.

At the reception event on Monday, December 15, all entries will be on display and teams and community members are invited to attend to cast their final votes and see which team is crowned the Gingerbread Champions. We encourage teams to have representatives present at the reception to drum up excitement, inspire votes for their entry, and receive any awards presented.

Awards:

At the reception on Monday, December 15, the entry that receives the most votes/donations during the online voting and at the reception will receive the Gingerbread Champions Trophy. Other awards will be given that may include: Judge's Choice, Most Creative, Most Detailed, Most Festive, and Best Use of Theme.

REGISTRATION

Teams:

Due to spacing limitations, the number of entries will be capped at 30. You are encouraged to submit your entry form early and before the deadline to ensure entry into the competition. You can submit your completed and signed copy of the Competitor Entry Form by email at director@franklinunitedway.org or in person.

One person must be designated as the Team Captain. Team Captains must be older than 18 years of age at the time of the competition date. This person will receive all notifications for the team. There is no limit to the amount of members on each team.

Entry Fee:
